The AIGA Atlanta Student Board is the education committee of AIGA Atlanta. The AIGA Atlanta Education Chair, a member of the AIGA Atlanta professional board, oversees the Student Board. Any student who is a current paid member of AIGA can apply for an officer position by contacting the Education Chair.

Meetings: Monthly meetings are typically held from 1–3pm on the Saturday prior to the first Monday of each month. Locations vary from member schools, local studios or restaurants.

Programming: Student members from the different schools are requested to host or facilitate an event or activity that benefits all schools and to which all students may participate. The Student Board works with the school to provide support services through AIGA resources. Currently established events include the annual Student Pinup Show and Type Fight.
